

**Graves under the National School extension - as taken from surviving records prior to building and expanded  
thanks to surveying carried out by Burial Ground Management System in 2024**

This transcript relies on photography and prior transcripts, as well as research carried out by FOCCT to identify the owners of plots with plot markers.

Where we suspect a stone was displaced, we have indicated which grave we believe that stone belongs with.

Stones which have gone missing since 2001 are highlighted pink.
